On April 5, 2017, Legislative Consultants Steve Ovel and Dave Palmer were joined by fellow lawmakers and Legislators in the Iowa House to hear House Concurrent Resolution 6 presented by the Pioneer Lawmakers Association of Iowa to honor those who have committed twenty or more years to the cause of politics in our state.

Dave Palmer has dedicated his life to the passions of politics and education. He began his Community College career in 1968 and served at Iowa Lakes, Southwestern and Des Moines Area Community College before committing himself full time to advocacy in 1992.
